

Day 01 – Nov. 1, 2007

Leaving San Francisco for Beijing, China.



Day 02 - Nov. 02 Beijing

Upon arrival in Beijing, you are met by your local guide and transferred to your hotel.



Day 03 - Nov. 03 Beijing (B, L, SD)

After breakfast, visit Tiananmen Square, then enter the Forbidden City, home of Chinese Emperors for more than 500 years. After lunch, visit the Temple of Heaven, one of the finest examples of Ming Dynasty architecture in Beijing. Attend a welcome banquet featuring Beijing Roast Duck.



Day 04 - Nov. 04 Beijing (B, L, D)

The highlight today is an excursion to the Great Wall at Juyongguan. Enjoy the dramatic vistas and marvel at the Wall as it climbs and descends steep ridges and narrow valleys. After lunch, visit the Summer Palace, located outside the city on Kunming Lake. Wander the gardens and covered walkways, and admire the 17-arch bridge. Enjoy the Acrobatic Show in the evening.



Day 05 - Nov. 05 Beijing/Xi'an (B, L, D)

After breakfast, enjoy a pedicab tour of the Hutongs, the “old city” neighborhood of narrow lanes and courtyard gardens hidden behind Beijing’s modern façade. Visit local families. Transfer to the airport for your midday flight to Xi’an, and transfer to the Hyatt Regency (or similar). Enjoy a brief city tour including the Ancient City Walls.



Day 06 - Nov. 06 Xi'an (B, L, SD)

Today’s highlight is a visit to the Archaeological Museum, home to more than 6,000 life-size terra-cotta warriors and horses excavated from the tomb of the first emperor of the Qin Dynasty. After lunch, visit the Shaanxi Provincial Museum, renowned for its collection of antiquities. In the evening, attend a special dinner and cultural show recreating the costumes, music and dance of the Tang Dynasty.

Day 07 - Nov. 07 Xi'an - Nanchang - Ji'An (B, L)

Visit the Big Wild Goose Pagoda and the Bell Tower. Take afternoon flight to Nanchang and transfer you to Ji'An. Stay overnight at WenShan International Hotel(4 star).





Day 08: - Nov 08 Ji'An (B)

Pay an official visit to this Sister City of Solano County. Arrangement will be made before the tour departure.



Day 09 - Nov 09. Ji'An - Nanchang –Guangzhou-Guilin (B, L, D)

Transfer you to Nanchang airport for your flight to Guangzhou, and connect your flight to Guilin. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. It is a busy day traveling by ground and air.



Day 10 – Nov. 10 Guilin/Yangshuo (B, L)

Today's excursion is a cruise along the beautiful Li River. Experience the magical beauty of limestone rock formations and farmland commonly seen in Chinese landscape paintings. Disembark at the charming village of Yangshuo, which has one of the best antique and craft markets in China.

You'll have time to browse the market and enjoy the local cafes. Dinner will be arranged by yourself to explore this fantastic small town. Overnight in Yangshuo.



Day 11 Nov 11 Yangshuo/Guilin/Guangzhou (B, L, D)

In the morning, enjoy a sightseeing tour of the countryside, including a visit to Crescent Moon Hill with scenic vistas of the area. Then transfer back to Guilin and enjoy sightseeing with a city tour, including Reed Flute Cave, Elephant Trunk Hill and Fubo Hill. In the afternoon transfer to airport and fly to Guangzhou. Meet and transfer to China Hotel or similar.



Day 12 - Nov 12 Guangzhou/Zhongshan (B, L, D)

After breakfast, take bus to transfer to Zhongshan, some local tours will be arranged. Stay in Zhongshan International Hotel(4 star).

Day 13 - Nov 13 Zhongshan (B)

Free at leisure.



Day 14 - Nov 14 Zhongshan-Hong Kong (B)

Transfer to pier and take ferry to Hong Kong. Meet your local guide at pier and transfer to your hotel. Both lunch and dinner will be under clients own arrangement.

Day 15 Nov 15 Hong Kong (B, L)

Today's half day sightseeing tour gives an introduction to Hong Kong Island, including visits to Victoria Peak, Repulse Bay, Stanley Market and Aberdeen Fishing Village. Enjoy a dim-sum lunch before returning to your hotel. Afternoon at leisure.

Day 16 - Nov 16 Hong Kong (B)

Free Day for you to do some shopping, prepare to return to San Francisco.

Day 17 Nov 17 Hong Kong/San Francisco (B)

After breakfast transfer to the airport for your flight back to San Francisco.
